

## Washington USL&H Assigned Risk Plan (WARP) Summary of Application Process\*

### Coverage is effective only when expressly stated in writing by SeaBright Insurance Company.

1. Only a WARP application can be used to apply for WARP coverage. The application is available from SeaBright Insurance Company or as a download from the WARP website at <http://warp-uslh.org>.
2. Information regarding coverages and coverage limits are also available from SeaBright or from the WARP website.
3. The submitting producer must be acting as a representative of the applicant. No producer is authorized to act as an agent of SeaBright or WARP for any transaction or process involving the Washington USL&H Assigned Risk Plan. The producer must complete the application showing a valid WA producer license number. Producers must meet bond requirements under Washington state law and provide surety information on the application.
4. No coverage is provided by the submission of an application with or without a deposit premium.
5. No producer, broker or agent has any authority to bind coverage at any time.
6. The earliest available effective date for eligible applicants is not earlier than 12:01 a.m. on the first day following receipt by the servicing carrier of the completed application and required deposit premium. In some cases, U.S. mail postmarks or third party mail or courier service dates may be recognized in determining the earliest available effective date; please call SeaBright to discuss options when timing is critical. NEVER assume coverage is bound.
7. WARP policies are direct bill but the deposit premium must be guaranteed and an insured's check is not acceptable for the deposit. The deposit premium must be a broker check or wire transfer of funds payable to SeaBright Insurance Company.
